We do not have many details about Anton's life.

The details we do have about Anton are conflicting.

## BIRTH

He was the sixth child of John B. Haas and Kunigunda Brendel-Haas. There isn't a birth certificate on file at the Sauk County Court House. According to the 1900 Federal Census and his death Certificate he was born on October 1, 1890.

## DEATH

According to his death certificate he died on December 26, 1910 ( vol 7 page 102 ). He died at 9:40 am. He died of pulmonary tuberculosis. (His brother George died of the same disease 8 years later. )He had this sickness for 200 days. Dr. Fowler attended Anton from March 1, 1910 to September 1, 1910.

According to the August 1910 Federal Census, his brothers George and Ludwig and his sisters Tillie and Clara were still living at home when he died.

## OBITUARY

Anton's obituary appeared in the Dec 29, 1910 Home News.

*Anton Haas, son of Mr. and Mrs. John B. Haas of Franklin who has been a sufferer with tuberculosis died at home Monday, December 26, 1910. He was 20 years old. Funeral was Wednesday at St. Lukes conducted by Fr. Pesch. Mrs. Issac Morgan of Chicago was at the*

*funeral.*

Mrs. Issac Morgan was his older sister Lena Morgan.

## CONFLICTS

His tombstone shows a birthdate of 1880 and a deathdate of 1909. The 1880 birthdate has to be wrong because John B. Haas and family did not come to America until 1882 and Anton's name was not on the passenger list.

According to John B. Haas's and Kunigunda Brendel-Haas's obituaries, Anton died in 1911. Again the death certificate and obituary provide a more reliable date.
